### ARRIVAL

Please plan to arrive at the Ranch **Monday thru Friday between 7:30 and 8:00 a.m.**

A parent, guardian or a responsible adult must accompany ALL campers and sign them in and out each day.

All medications and canteen money are to be handed in at registration on Monday.

Please call and leave a message if your child will be absent or late.

### DEPARTURE

**Monday to Thursday pick up is from 5:00 – 5:30 p.m.** The daily program ends at 5:00 p.m. If early pick up is needed please let us know the morning of, so we can make sure your child is ready.

Friday sign out will take place at 4:30. This is a great time for your camper to show you what they have been up to all week.

**ALL CAMPERS** must be signed out prior to departure.

Any medication, and canteen return will be handed out at sign-out.

### MEDICATION

Medical care is a vital part of our role for your child(ren) at the Ranch. Please advise us at registration if there are any changes to your child(ren)'s medical information. **The Ranch reserves the right to refuse admission to any Rancher with a suspected contagious condition (eg. Chickenpox or lice).** To ensure your child(ren) has an enjoyable week, and to protect other ranchers, please have any condition treated completely before coming to camp. If this is not possible, please call and reschedule to another week, depending on availability. Due to the structure of our program, U-Turn Ranch requests that medications required throughout the year be sent with your child(ren) to camp.

### LOST & FOUND

We do not assume responsibility for lost or damaged items. **Lost and found will be held till the end of August than donated to a local charity.**

### ALLERGIES

If a special diet is required please contact the ranch office for a menu and substitutions may be brought. U-Turn Ranch will make every effort to accommodate allergies, however can not guarantee that there will be no trace of the allergen in the food served.

### DIRECTIONS FROM

**New Hamburg** – Take 7&8 west to Shakespeare. Turn left at lights. In Tavistock follow Hwy 59 south. Just past Premier John Deere turn right on Oxford Road 34. We are first on the left.

**Stratford** – Take 7&8 east to Shakespeare. Turn right at lights. In Tavistock follow Hwy 59 south. Just past Premier John Deere turn right on Oxford Road 34. We are first on the left.

**Woodstock** – Take Hwy 59 North to Tavistock. Minutes past Hickson turn left on Oxford Road 34. We are the first on the left right across from Premier John Deere.

### MAIL

We will do pony express every day. Feel free to send letters for your camper on Monday morning and we will deliver them throughout the week.

### LICE CHECKS

A lice check will be preformed the Monday morning of registration. Please be advised that if there are any lice or nits discovered, rancher will be sent home to be treated and than allowed back to camp once heads are clean. If there is anything that we are unsure of on head, we require that public health clears them before returning. There are no refunds for these situations. So we strongly encourage parents to check before coming.

### CANTEEN

The Canteen will be open everyday for the campers to purchase a snack. The Canteen includes things such as chocolate bars, chips, candy, and pop. We have also included some healthy choices, so if you camper would prefer this, there will be some options. We have a limit of \$3.00 per day. Every item being \$1.50. **Please bring money on Monday for registration** and extra money will be returned at the end of the week.

### WHAT TO BRING!!!

1. Swimsuit and towel
2. Life Jacket **if required.**
3. Long pants for horsemanship. Helmets will be provided.
4. A solid shoe with a minimum 1.5 cm heal for riding.
5. Running Shoes
6. Sandles – these are **NEEDED** as it gets very hot.
7. Rain gear
8. Extra set of cloths – Extra socks
9. Sunscreen and insect repellent
10. Baseball hat for sun-shade
11. Water bottle

A hook will be provided for your camper to hang their items for the week. Items may be left from day to day.

Please do not bring IPODS, or cell phones. It can be very distracting to your camper and others. Campers should not carry money with them. All money should be handed in at registration.

### MEALS

Lunch and a small morning snack will be provided. Daycampers will have the option of going to the Canteen to purchase an afternoon snack. Please do not send food along with your camper due to food allergies, unless previously arranged.
