

BEHAVIOURAL AND ONE ON ONE SUPPORT POLICY

U-Turn Ranch Campers participate in groups generally made up of campers around the same age. A camper who finds it difficult to participate in a group setting is welcome at U-Turn Ranch, however we require that these campers participate with a one-on-one worker, provided by the family. This includes challenges with group participation, following group directions, listening to staff, making safe choices, speech, toileting, changing, comprehension, flight risk, hands on, bad language, inappropriate conversations or respect of other campers and staff. Our staff are unable to provide one-on-one attention to a particular camper if it requires our staff to be pulled away from the group.

Failure to inform U-Turn Ranch of these needs, will result in the camper requiring a one-on-one worker for the remainder of their camp week provided by the family. U-Turn Ranch is not responsible if a one-on-one worker is unable to be arranged, and a refund will not be issued.

It is very important that your camper and other campers is set up for success in all of these areas. Should this be a concern, please contact our office prior to confirming registration.
