



How to go about booking your retreat at U-Turn Ranch.

- 1. Contact the office by email to tentatively book the date you would like.
- 2. Fill out the Retreat info sheet and return to our office.
- 3. A deposit of \$300 is required to hold your booking. The deposit is non-refundable, but will be credited to your final invoice, as long as no damage occurred during your time at U-Turn. If you require an invoice, please let us know and we will email one to you.
- 4. Contact the Insurance Company for your organization and request a "Certificate of Insurance" naming U-Turn Ranch, Woodstock, ON, as additional insured. Please send a copy via email.
- 5. Please inform all your participants of U-Turn Ranch's Rental Policies and collect a completed release form from each participant.
- 6. Two weeks prior, inform us if your numbers have changed and of any food allergies that could affect your participants time at U-Turn.
- 7. Final payment must be taken care of before or at arrival. Etransfers can be sent to office@uturnranch.com or if paying by check please send 2 weeks prior to arrival.
- 8. Ensure all release forms are handed in at arrival.

Planning your retreat

PACKAGES AND PRICING – HST will be added to the price

All prices are based on a 20-person minimum.

We can accommodate up to 64 people overnight.

RANCH RUN ACTIVITIES – If included in your package

Programming by U-Turn Ranch staff will be scheduled Saturday morning between Breakfast and Lunch. Activities run for 1 hour in length each. Depending on the size of your group, we may need to run in a rotation of groups. Activities will be led by U-Turn staff. If participates are under 18, there will need to be adult supervision of participants at all times along with our staff. Activity options are as follows:

Horse Rides -This activity will start with a brief instruction. Each participant will have the opportunity to get up on a horse for a ride in our indoor riding arena. This is led by our experienced horse staff at U-Turn Ranch. While participants are not riding, they will be able to groom and interact with some of our other horses, supervised by chaperones if comfortable. This program is based on age and experience of riders.

Archery - During archery participants will learn about safety in the archery range, how to string a bow, how to aim and shoot an arrow. They will have lots of time to test out their skills and shooting ability. Archery takes place in an area all on its own and there will be strict rules that go with the activity.

Orienteering - During orienteering participants will learn the basics of how to use a compass, parts of a compass and how to follow a bearing. Then the students will navigate and travel around U-Turn Ranch to find clues to solve a problem. This is suggested for age 8 and up.

Scavenger Hunt – Scavenger hunt is for students ages 10 and under. Participants will be able to discover nature and the grounds of U-Turn Ranch.

Team Building – Team building is a set of exercises that require the entire group's participation to solve. Team building gives participants the opportunity to develop their problem-solving skills, listening and cooperation skills, communication, and creative thinking. Groups will plan, discuss, set a goal and then participate as a group to accomplish the task at hand.

Frisbee Golf – This is a game much like mini golf; however, it is played with a Frisbee and pylons. Small groups will travel around to see who can win!

Pool – The pool can only be used from the beginning of June though August. Please be aware that there is an extra charge for this activity.

MEALS

Below is an example of what the menu would look like for the weekend. Please note that this can changed and is not always the same from weekend to weekend. This menu is also based on the full package, and will be altered according to the package you choose.

U-TURN RENTAL POLICIES

Please ensure that everyone attending is aware of U-Turn Ranch Policies below.

Reservations – No reservation is confirmed until deposit and retreat info sheet are returned to U-Turn Ranch. **Cancellations** – Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Deposit & Payment – We ask for a non-refundable deposit of \$300 to confirm the date. This deposit will be credited to your final invoice, if there are no damages during your stay at U-Turn. Once the retreat info sheet and deposit are received in our office, your booking will be confirmed. Two weeks prior to your arrival, we ask that you contact our office if your numbers are different than stated on your retreat info sheet. We give allowance for a 25% adjustment. An invoice will be sent two weeks prior to your arrival. Payment is due upon before or at arrival. Please send payment via etransfer or bring cash. If paying by check, pre-approval is required by our office.

Release Forms - Please ensure that Release Forms are filled out for all participants prior to arrival, including chaperons. Everyone under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian sign. We ask that these forms are handed in when you arrive. Please find the form below.

Kitchen – Please note that our kitchen is closed to rental groups. Only U-Turn Staff are allowed in the kitchen. **Food allergies** – We require notification of all allergies 2 weeks in advance. Should there need to be adjustments to our menu for any participant, we ask that substitutions be brought, if we are not able to easily adjust our menu.

Arrival Times – For Friday arrivals, we ask that groups arrive after 6 pm. Retreat facilitators are welcome to arrive anytime after 5 pm. Should you require an earlier time, please contact our office. We require 10 minutes upon the entire groups arrival, to chat through basic instructions, facility boundaries and emergency procedures. **Departure Times** – If your retreat is closing on Saturday, we ask that all participants are gone by 8 pm. If your retreat closes on Sunday, we ask that all participates are gone by 2 pm. Should you require a time beyond, please contact our office.

Alcohol and Non-prescription drugs and are not permitted on the premises.

Smoking and Vaping is prohibited at U-Turn Ranch. Should this be an issue, please contact us ahead of time. **Facility Care** – Groups renting U-Turn Ranch facilities are responsible for all damages beyond normal wear and tear to equipment, buildings, facilities, and grounds, and will be charged accordingly. We ask that no furniture be moved without permission from U-Turn Ranch staff.

Bedding – Bedding and towels are not provided by U-Turn Ranch. Please remind guests to bring warm bedding as the wagons are not heated.

Supervision for groups under Age 18 – Groups are required to provide adequate supervision at all times while at U-Turn Ranch. This includes meal times and ranch run activities. Our staff will facilitate, but it is the groups responsibility to oversee participants.

Nature & Wildlife – We ask that you let the nature of U-Turn Ranch not be disturbed. No cutting or removing twigs, leaves and bark from trees or picking flowers. We also ask that you respect all wildlife and do not hang on or climb on trees.

Garbage and Recycling – Garbage cans and blue boxes are available throughout the camp grounds. Please use them and do not litter.

Vehicles – All vehicles should be parked in the U-Turn Ranch parking lot. This is the driveway directly across from the John Deere Dealership's driveway, not the house driveway. Please drive slow coming in and out. We ask that no vehicle be driven on any grassy areas.

Noise – Please be considerate of others. There should be no loud music or yelling between 10 pm and 8 am. **Pond/River/Lake** – We ask that all water areas are not used, unless prior arrangements are made.

Pool – The pool is generally open from beginning of June till end of August, and can be used for an additional cost. We will do our best to provide a lifeguard, however, should U-turn not be able to provide a lifeguard for your required time, we welcome you to provide a NLS certified lifeguard who is at minimum 18 years old and

has experience. Qualifications would be required by our office 2 weeks in advance and lifeguard would be required to be on site at least 45 minutes prior to your swimming time to ensure they are comfortable with our facility and rules.

First Aid – Rental groups are responsible for their own first aid. Should there be an emergency, we have a first responder on property at most times.

Fires – are permitted only in existing fire areas. Please do not burn candles inside any facilities.

Fireworks - are not permitted at U-Turn.

Pets – We ask that no pets are brought to U-Turn Ranch.

Lost and Found – U-Turn Ranch is not responsible for any lost or forgotten articles. Lost and found articles not claimed within two weeks of your stay will be donated to the local second-hand store.

Out of Bounds – We ask that no one from the group goes into any buildings except for the dining hall and washrooms. The kitchen, walk in cooler, pool, fenced pasture area, private residences, program room and barns are off limits at all times unless lead by U-Turn Ranch staff.

Feeding/Petting animals – We ask that animals are not fed or touched unless a U-Turn Ranch staff member is present. Do not let anyone go into the fenced area or barn without a U-Turn Ranch staff member.

Dining Hall – We ask that the dining hall be cleared out at least $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before and after each meal for us to set up and clean up meals.

Shared Use – When small groups are booked, U-Turn reserves the right to book another group at the same time that your group is here. We will do everything possible to prevent groups from interfering with each other. **Accidents** – We ask that any accidents or damage is reported to the directors of U-turn Ranch.
